



Database Connection


## Data Provider

Code On Time Generator bases the generated web applications on an existing database. You can choose to select a database stored in SQL Server or Oracle by using the dropdown, as illustrated below.




## Connection String

You can insert your connection string to the database you would like to use in the field provided.




If you need assistance to build the connection string, then click on the link below to access the Connection String Builder. Type in your database in the first field and provide your credentials, if

necessary. Then type in your database name, or select from the dropdown. You can press the Test button to test the connection to the database.



## Database Tables

You can specify which tables and views you would like to be generated for your web application. This scope can be determined by using the link near the bottom of the page. A table selection window will appear, with a checkbox list of all the database tables and views in the application. Check the ones that you wish to generate. In the example below, only Customers and Employees tables were selected.



When you press Ok, the list of data objects will be updated with your selection.
